Launching our Road Safety Campaign: "Road Revolution"

We are writing to you because we are very worried about the amount of traffic in the village, and the number of people who are driving their children to school.

We used to have a lollipop lady, which meant we could have a Walking Bus to promote walking to school, with people leaving their cars at the Village Hall. But now we have no safe crossing, so the Walking Bus has stopped.

We have done a survey and found that 50% of children live in the village of Lubenham, but only a few are walking to school. Some of the reasons why they are not walking are:

- "three young children and busy roads"
- "no lollipop lady"
- "busy road crossing"
- "there is no safe walking/cycling route to school"

We think this is a problem because of the pollution caused by the cars, the parking problems outside the school, the danger to pedestrians and the lack of exercise for the children.

More houses are going up in the village and at Lubenham Hill, which means more cars on the road through our village. Also speeding is a "perpetual problem" according to the Parish Council.

A safe crossing, eg zebra, toucan or pedestrian, would help lots of people in the village too.



We are starting a petition to campaign for a safe crossing. We want you to support our campaign. Please let us know what you will be doing about this very important matter.
