### Welcome to Our New Pupils and Families

### New Routines

Thank you to our school community who have also helped to keep the school safe for all by following the new entrance and exit routes. Please leave the school grounds as soon as possible, keeping a safe distance from other adults and allowing children to enter/exit their classrooms. In order to limit the number of people on school grounds, wherever possible only one parent should be with their child at pick up and drop off times and following advice from the local authority all adults should now be wearing a mask at these times. If your child is displaying COVID symptoms, i.e. a temperature or a continuous cough or loss of taste, please do not send them or their siblings to school.

### Parent Pay

Parent Pay has now been set up for all our families. Breakfast, after school clubs and hot school dinners **must** be booked in this way. Lunch numbers are picked up by the kitchen staff, so it is important that you book school meals **in advance**. If you have any problems accessing Parent Pay, please call our school office.

### After School Clubs

Breakfast and After School clubs are now up and running. Sports clubs offered this term are football, basketball/netball, athletics, hockey and tennis. Children will stay in their bubbles during the sessions. Please book on Parent Pay.

If you are receiving a qualifying benefit your child may be eligible for Free School Meals - please call School Food Support on 0116 305 6588 to check. By registering you may also receive financial help for school trips and other activities. Please note this differs from the Universal Free School Meal system for children in Reception/Y1/Y2

### **Warm Clothing**

As it is getting colder, please ensure your child has appropriate, named, outdoor clothing and footwear as we endeavour to go outside every day - whatever the weather. Reception and year 1 children will need wellies. As we will be doing PE outside for the time being, please make sure your child has trainers rather than plimsolls if possible. Thankyou.

Milk is provided by Cool Milk. Parents/carers will need to register their child at [www.coolmilk.com](http://www.coolmilk.com) to start receiving milk. If your child is 4 then milk is free however this will still need to be ordered, if your child is 5 or older then milk will need to be paid for. Payments are made direct to Cool Milk and are usually paid each half term. Milk is stored in a refrigerator until just before it is served at morning break time.
