AFTER SCHOOL PROVISION:

ALDERMAN AND NEWTON TRUST:

Do you know someone in the village that might benefit with some help from the Alderman Newton Educational Foundation?

The foundation supports the education of people under 25, living in Lubenham Parish. It awards grants to young people who may need a little financial support towards their education or apprenticeship.

Trustees are concerned that many young people who are eligible, are not getting the funds they deserve. There is no means test – all you have to do is tell them what course/apprenticeship you are doing or are going to do, what you need and give them an idea of the cost.

They can help with things like books, IT equipment, tools, essential clothing e.g. safety boots or sports equipment.
